International Relations Committee

Council decision 2011/15 19 July 2011

- (1) In accordance with Article 10(5) of the Statute, the Council decides to establish the International Relations Committee (IRC) as a standing Council committee and to delegate the respective tasks and powers to the members of this committee.
- (2) The IRC will
 - develop a structured policy for the relations of ELI with institutions operating on a global or non-European level, such as the UNCITRAL, UNIDROIT, World Bank, American Law Institute, etc; and
 - make proposals for possible joint projects to be submitted to the Projects Committee and the Council.
- (3) Fabrizio Cafaggi and Bénédicte Fauvarque-Cosson are appointed as members of the IRC. Other members of the ELI Council who would like to join the IRC are invited to nominate themselves by 20 July 2011. If the IRC would otherwise become too big or significantly imbalanced, the two appointed members will make a choice, taking into account diversity as to legal traditions, disciplines and professional backgrounds, and the extent to which a Council member is prepared to contribute actively to the Committee's work. The IRC members will elect one or several chairpersons.
