

C R I Droit Entreprise Société The issue of gambling and the adequacy of the legal framework relating to gambling is more relevant than ever. Indeed, the emergence of new technologies and globalization overturned the sector. Current regulations do not always provide the flexibility required to meet the evolving needs of the market - despite the constant efforts of the Gaming Commission in adapting the regulation of the sector. The predictability of the rule is truly tested, as illustrated by the many questions that come to mind: how to articulate the European freedom to provide services with constraints such as the protection of players, whereas the development of Internet tends de facto to erase the state borders? How to strike a right balance between the necessary profitability of legal gambling (to prevent it from being replaced by an illegal offer) and the need to limit the losses suffered by players, who are sometimes addicted to these activities?

Gambling is an interdisciplinary field. In order to assess the existing legal mechanisms, it is essential to examine the sociological, psychological and medical aspects inherent to gambling, but also to understand the scope of the possibilities offered by the new technologies, to determine how their use could be regulated.

Finally, such a study could not be carried out without the professionals of the gaming industry, who will further enrich the debates with their concrete experience of the topic. At a time when important regulatory changes are discussed, gambling is more than ever a topic worthy of scientific and interdisciplinary reflexion.
