How to Travel From Vienna Airport to the University of Vienna

The Express Train S7

The S7 runs twice hourly, at 19 and 49 minutes past the hour from Vienna Airport to Wien Mitte (directly). It takes around 25 minutes and costs EUR 4,40. Tickets are available [online](#), at the ÖBB ticket counter at the airport, at ticket machines and via the [ÖBB ticket app](#). The Landstraße train (U-Bahn) station is also at Wien Mitte. From there take the U3 in the direction of Ottakring and exit at Volkstheater. The University is a 14 minute walk. Alternatively, take Tram 1 (direction Prater) and exit at Schottentor-Universität. From Wien Mitte, you can also take the U3 (direction Ottakring) to Volkstheater and switch to U2 (direction Seestadt). Exit at Schottentor-Universität U-Bahn.



CAT (City Airport Train)

The CAT train is an efficient way to travel to and from Vienna Airport. The journey to Wien Mitte station takes 16 minutes non-stop and costs EUR 14,90. The CAT train leaves at 8 and 38 minutes past the hour. At the airport, you can purchase your tickets at the counter, from ticket machines or from sales staff. Bus (Vienna Airport Lines, VAL)

VAL buses depart Vienna Airport to the city every 30 minutes. There are three routes. VAL 2 leaves every 15 and 45 minutes past the hour from 'Flughafen Wien Busterminal' (Vienna Airport Bus Terminal). It takes 25 minutes to get to Schwedenplatz directly. If booked [online](#), a single ticket costs EUR 9,50. To get from Schwedenplatz to the University of Vienna, take Tram 1 (direction Stefan-Fadinger-Platz) and exit at Schottentor-Universität.



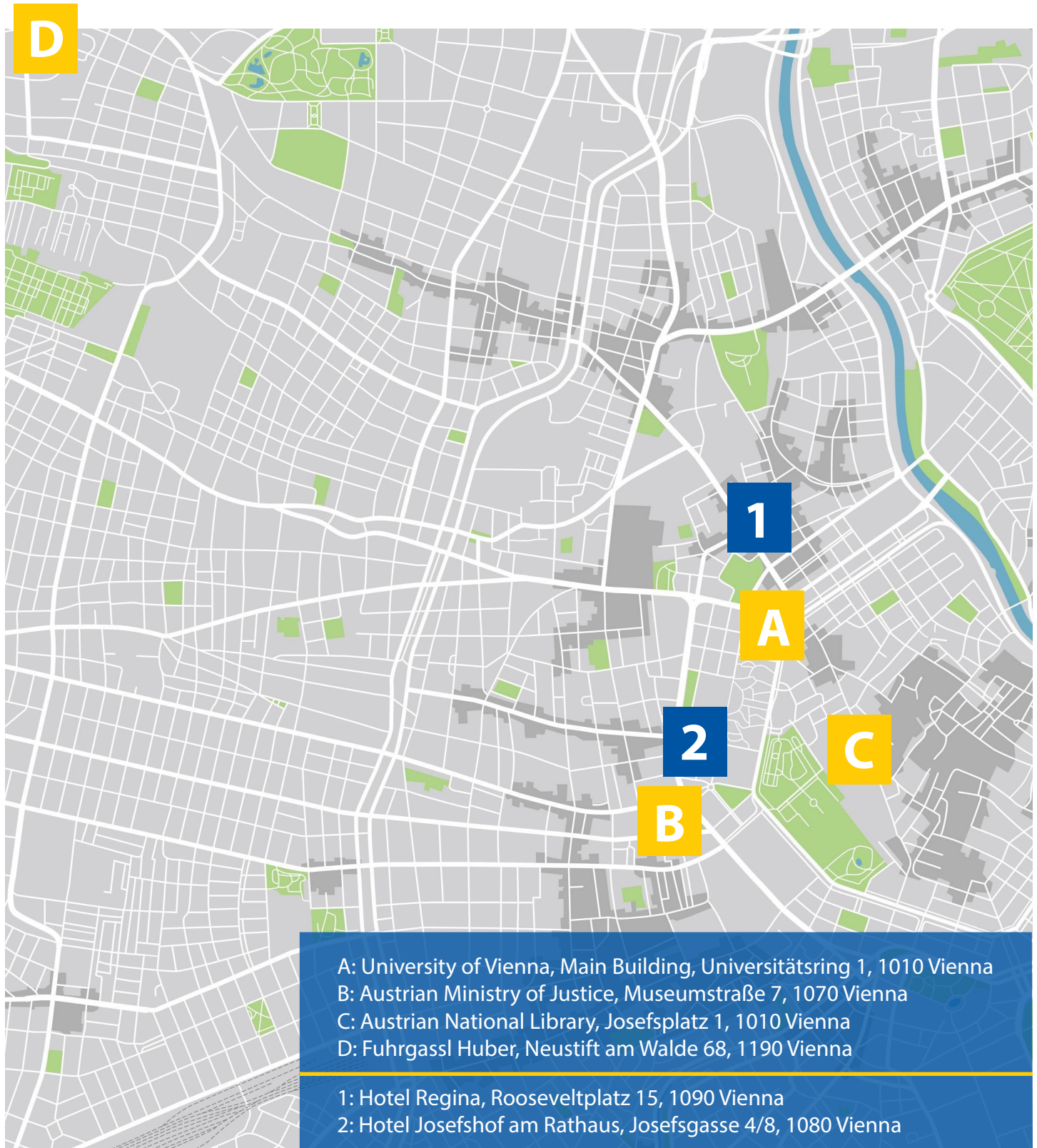
Taxis

There are several taxi counters inside the arrivals hall at Vienna Airport. Please note that taxi fares will only be reimbursed by ELI if no reasonable alternative is available using public transport and up to a maximum of EUR 40 for the entire trip. To book a taxi, you can also call 0043 140100.

How to get to the Opening Reception

From Hotel Regina: 20 minute walk or take the Tram 1, 71, D or U2Z from Schottentor and exit at Ring, Volkstheater U-Bahn station then walk.

From Hotel Josefshof: 5 minutes walk.



How to get to the Gala Dinner

Austrian National Library | Josefsplatz 1 | 1010 Vienna

From Hotel Regina: 17 minutes walk or take Bus 1A from Schottentor U-Bahn to Habsburgergasse, Bus 2A from Schottentor to Albertinaplatz, or Tram 1, 71, D or UsZ from Schottentor to Oper, Karlsplatz U-Bahn and walk.

From Hotel Josefshof: 18 minutes walk or take the U3 from Volkstheater to Herrengasse and walk. Alternatively, take Tram 2 from Rathaus to Oper or Tram 1, 71, D or UsZ from Parlament to Oper and walk.

How to get to the Social Event

Fuhrgassl Huber | Neustift am Walde 68 | 1190 Vienna

From Hotel Regina: take Tram 38 from Schwarzschanerstraße to Gatterburggasse or Tram 42 from Schwarzschanerstraße to Währinger Straße Volksoper U-Bahn, then Bus 35A. Exit at Neustift am Walde.

From Hotel Josefshof: take Tram 38 from Schottentor to Gatterburggasse or Tram D from Parlament to Liechtenwerder Platz, then Bus 35A to Neustift am Walde.
