

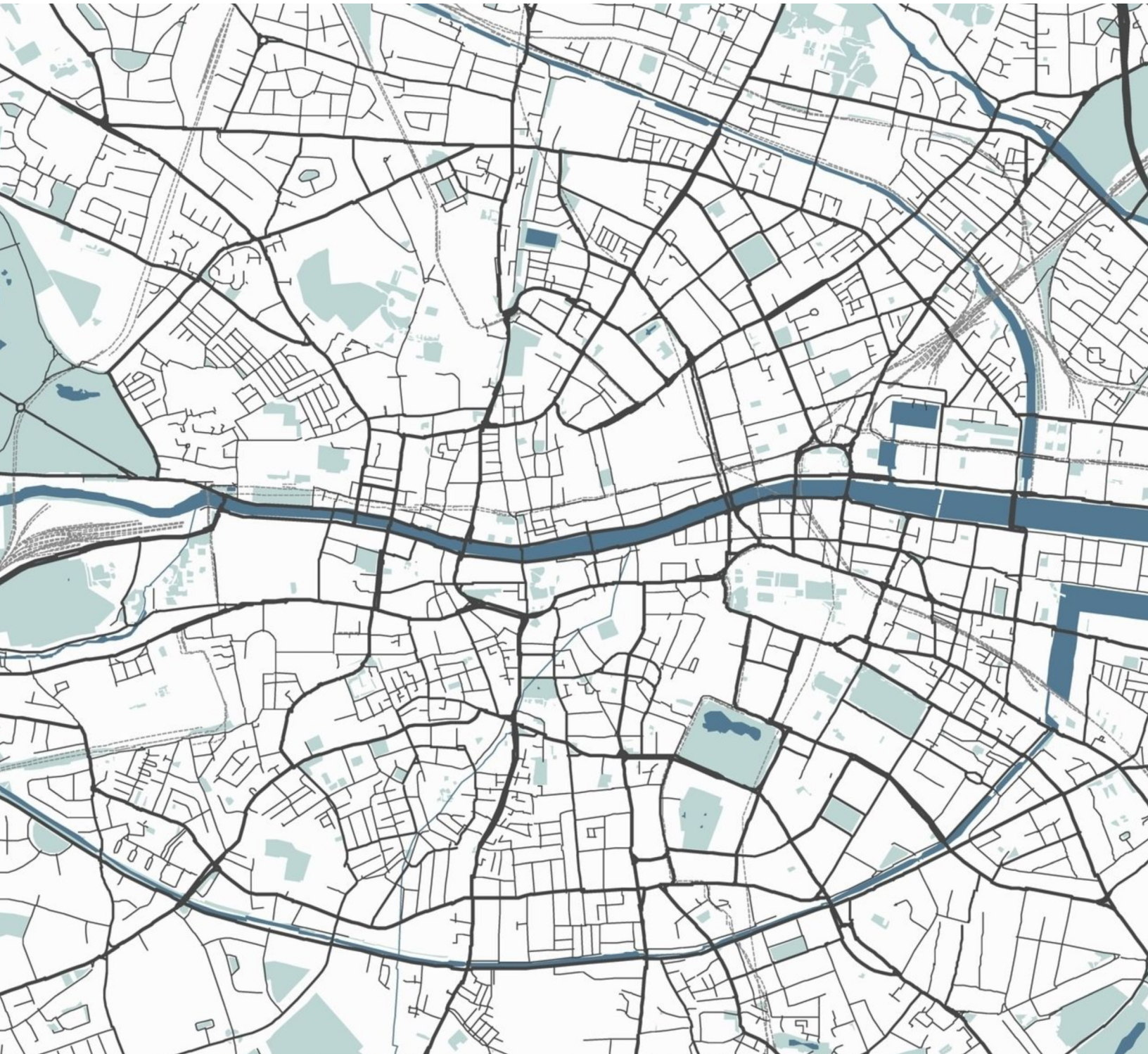

# Dublin Rail, Tram and Airport Bus Services

### Key to lines

**High frequency**  
(Usually every 5-15 minutes, Mon-Sat)

- DART Train
- Lus Red Line Tram
- Lus Green Line Tram

**Medium frequency**  
(check timetables before travel)

- Aircorch Bus 700
- Northern Commuter Train
- Southwestern Commuter Train
- Western Commuter Train

**Low frequency**  
(check timetables before travel)

- Southeastern Commuter Train

DART trains run less frequently to these stations. Please check timetables before travel.

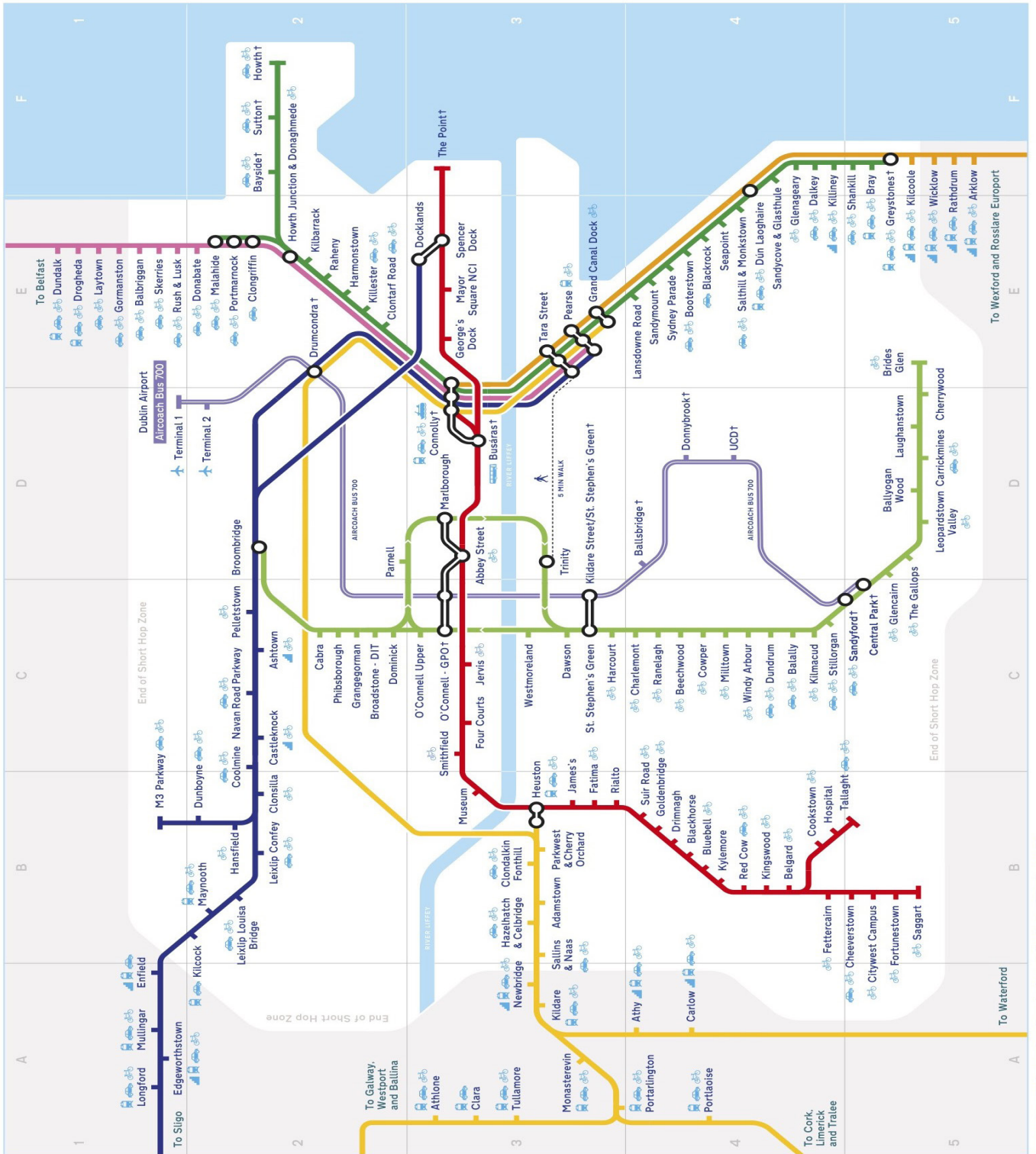
**† Aircorch buses**

You can travel to Dublin Ferryport on a 55 bus from outside Connolly Station. Always check timetables before travel.

# Dublin Airport to City

## Dublin Bus

Bus 16 from Zone 15 (view the Dublin Airport bus stop map [here](#)) costs EUR 2,00 one way. Payment can be made in coins (exact fare only) to the driver on the bus or with pre-paid tickets, which can be purchased at retail outlets or ticket machines at selected bus stops. Allow approximately an hour to reach the city centre. Timetable [here](#). Disembark at O'Connell Street. From there, it is a 17-minute walk to King's Inn or a 13-minute walk to Hampton by Hilton.



## Dublin Express Bus

The Dublin Express runs between Dublin Airport and Dublin City every 10 minutes during peak times. The journey to King's Inn or Hampton by Hilton takes just under an hour and costs EUR 8,00 one way or EUR 10,00 for a return ticket. Tickets can be purchased [online](#) or by card from the driver, subject to availability in the latter case. Disembark at Wellington Quay for a 15-minute walk to King's Inn or a 9-minute walk to Hampton by Hilton.



## Aircoach

Aircoach departs from Dublin Airport for Dublin City every 15 minutes. The journey to King's Inn or Hampton by Hilton takes approximately an hour and 15 minutes and costs EUR 10,00 one way or EUR 15,00 for a return ticket. Tickets can be purchased [online](#) or from the driver as you board. Timetable [here](#). Disembark at O'Connell Street. From there, it is a 17-minute walk to King's Inn and a 13-minute walk to Hampton by Hilton.



## Taxi

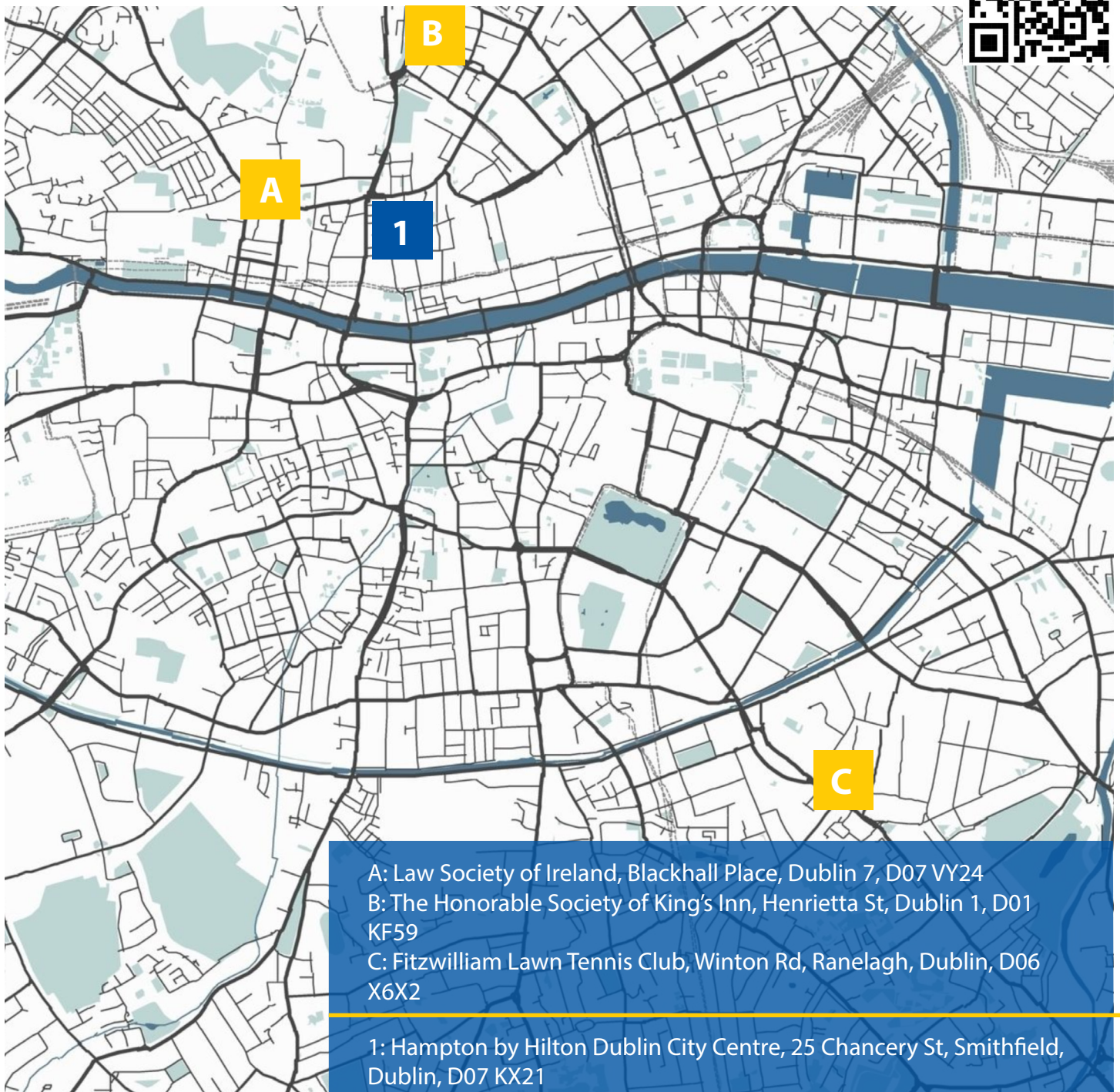
Passengers arriving at Dublin airport should follow taxi signage from Terminal 1 and Terminal 2 to the taxi ranks outside both terminals. A taxi dispatcher is available at each rank if you need further information or assistance. You are entitled to have fares calculated on the taxi meter and a receipt printed by the taximeter. Please click [here](#) to use the Transport for Ireland taxi fare estimator tool to estimate your taxi fare. All figures are approximate and depend on traffic congestion. For taxi services, you can contact Lynk Taxis at +353 (01) 471 5333.



Like many capital cities, Dublin has areas that are best avoided. Levels of crime are relatively limited. But as an extra precaution, when walking, stick to the main streets

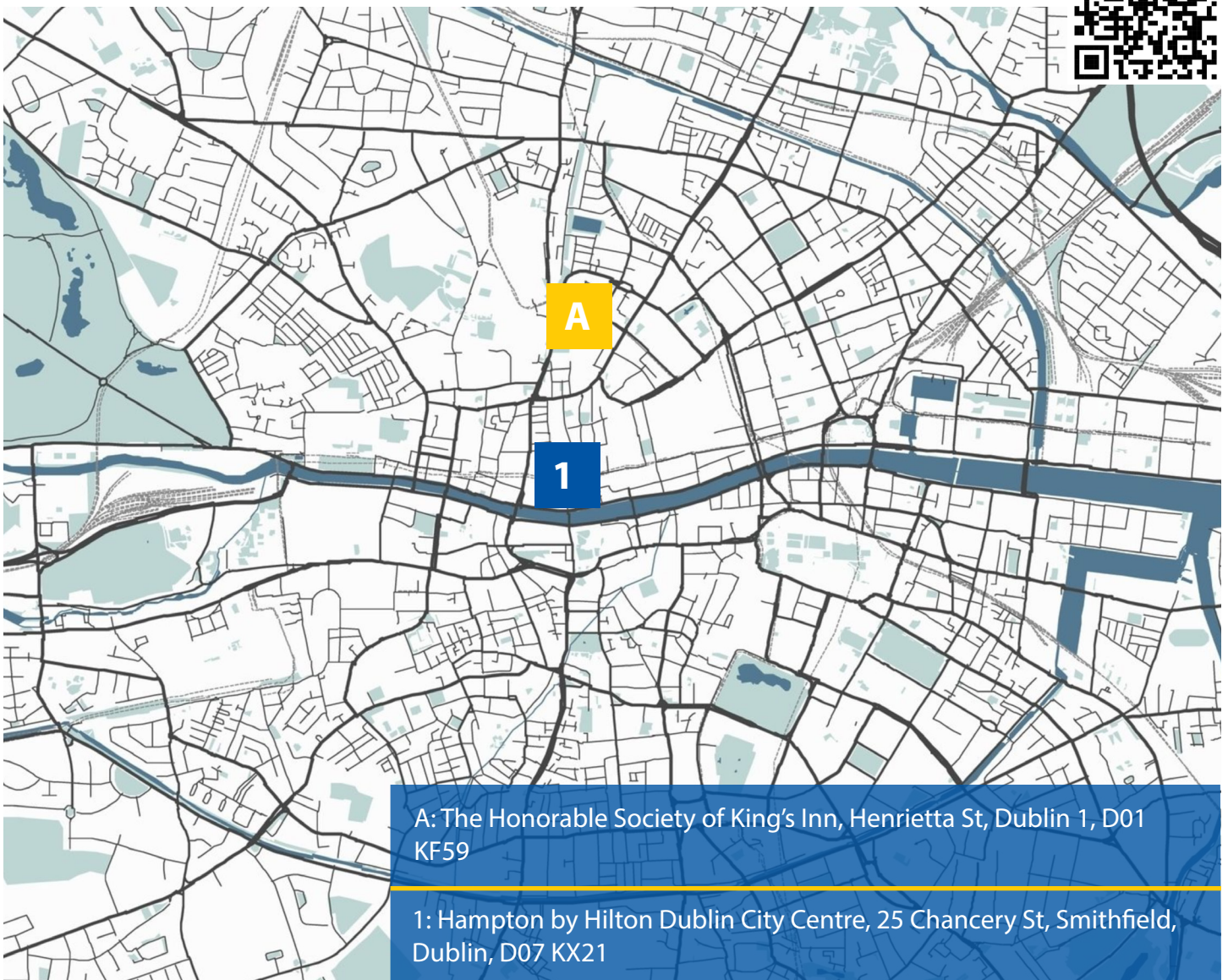


# How to get to King's Inn



## Henrietta St, Dublin 1, D01 KF59

From Hampton by Hilton Dublin: It is a 13-minute walk. Alternatively, head to St Michan's Church, Smithfield (2-minute walk). Take bus 83 or 83A in the direction of Harristown. Alight at Constitution Hill, Grangegorman. King's Inn is a 4-minute walk. The total journey takes approximately 10 minutes.

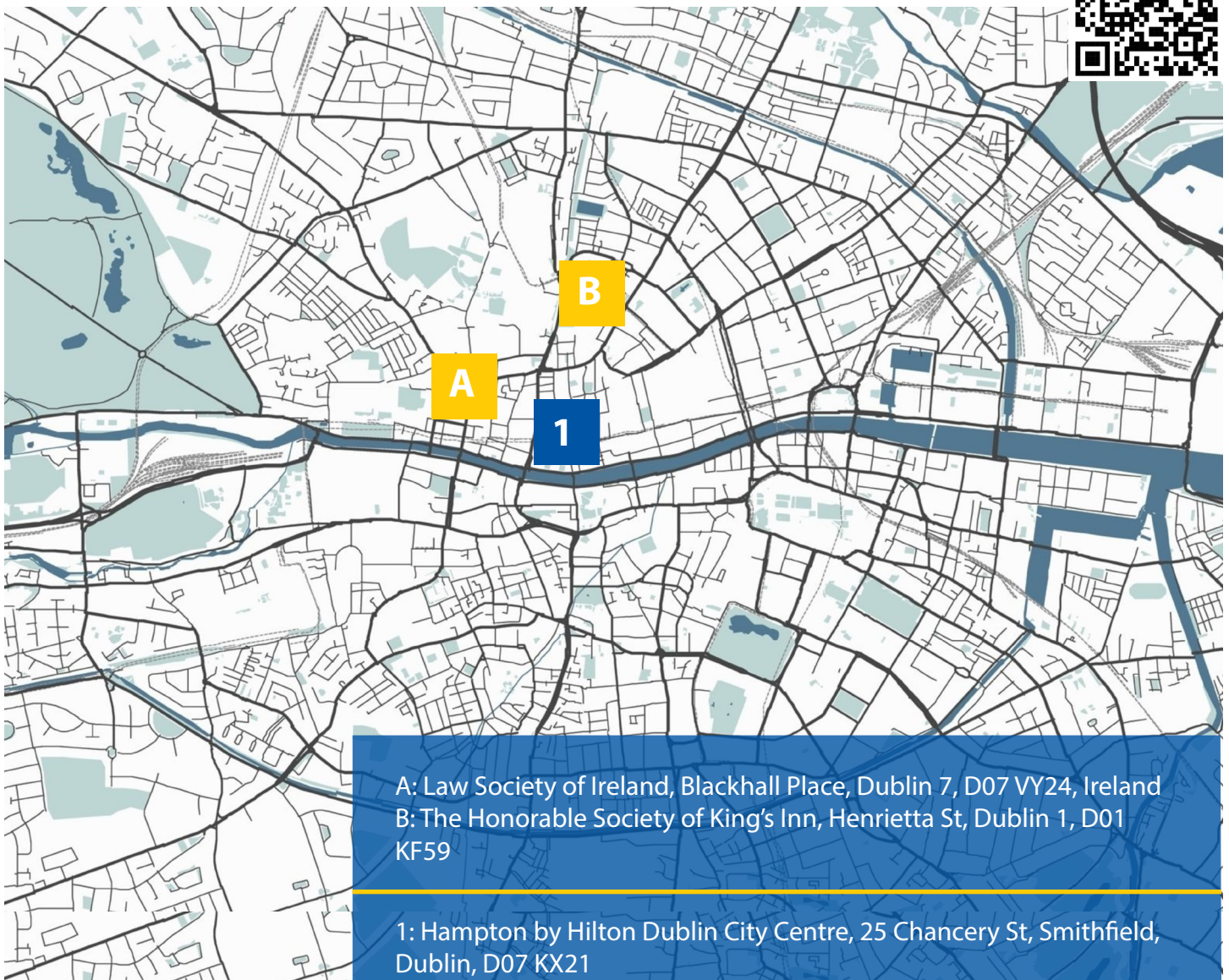
# How to get to the Law Society of Ireland



## **Blackhall Place, Dublin 7, D07 VY24**

From Hampton by Hilton Dublin: It is a 12-minute walk. Alternatively, head to Four Courts Luas tram stop (2-minute walk). Take the Red Line tram in the direction of Tallaght. Exit at Smithfield, and then walk for 6 minutes. The total journey takes approximately 10 minutes.

From King's Inn: 13-minute walk.



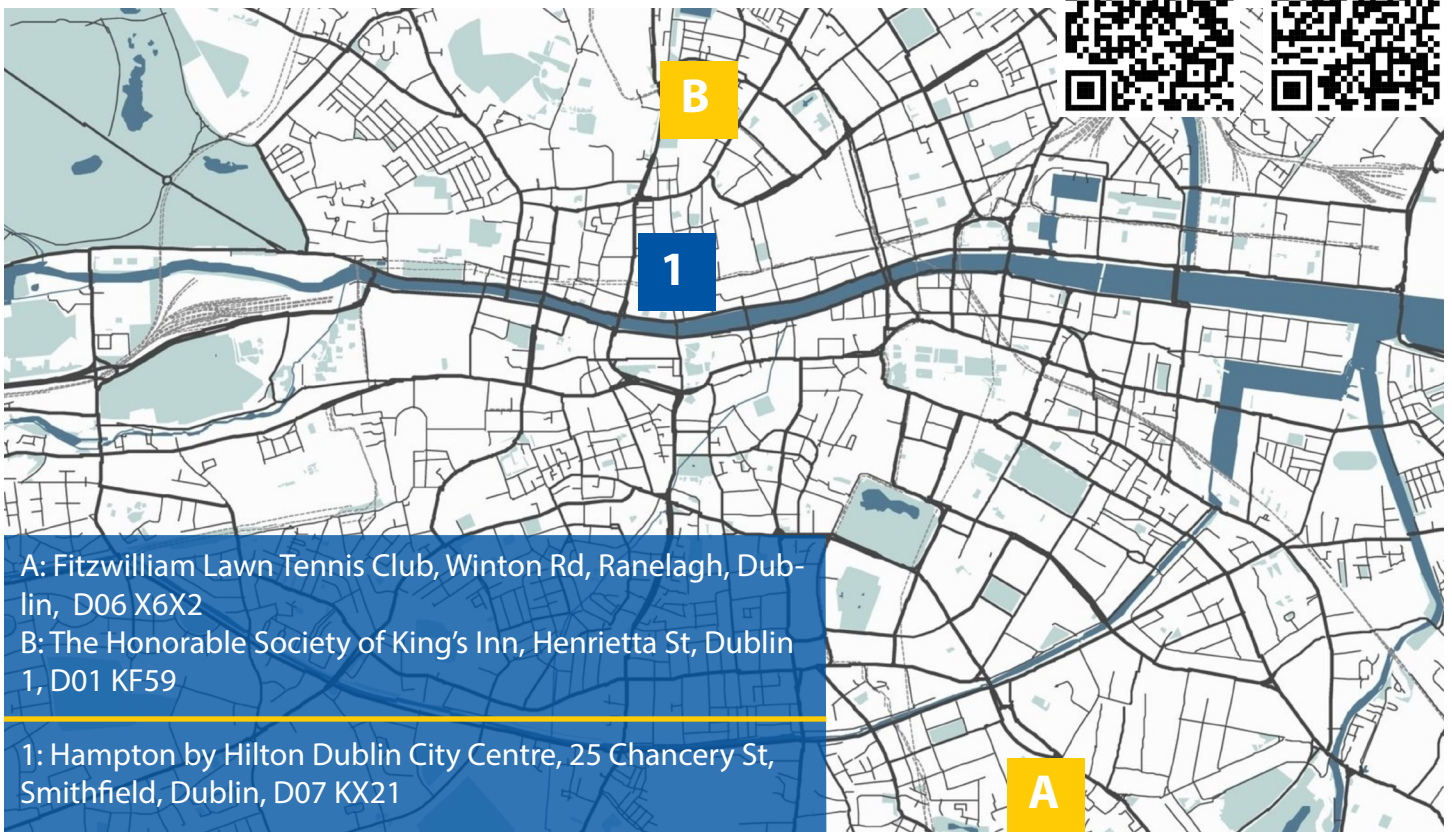
# How to get to Fitzwilliam Lawn Tennis Club



## Winton Rd, Ranelagh, Dublin, D06 X6X2

From Hampton by Hilton Dublin: Head to Four Courts (2-minute walk). Take bus 39A in the direction UCD. Alight at Wellington Lane. The Tennis Club is a 8-minute walk. The total journey takes approximately 35 minutes.

From King's Inn: Head to Broadstone, Phibsborough (5-minute walk). Take bus 155 in the direction of Bray. Alight at Sussex Road, Dublin City South. The Tennis Club is a 7-minute walk. The total journey takes approximately 35 minutes. Alternatively, take the Green Line tram from Broadstone (direction Brides Glen) and exit at Ranelagh. From there, it is a 12 minute-walk to the Club. The total journey takes approximately 41 minutes.

For Grand Canal and Georgian Dublin Tour

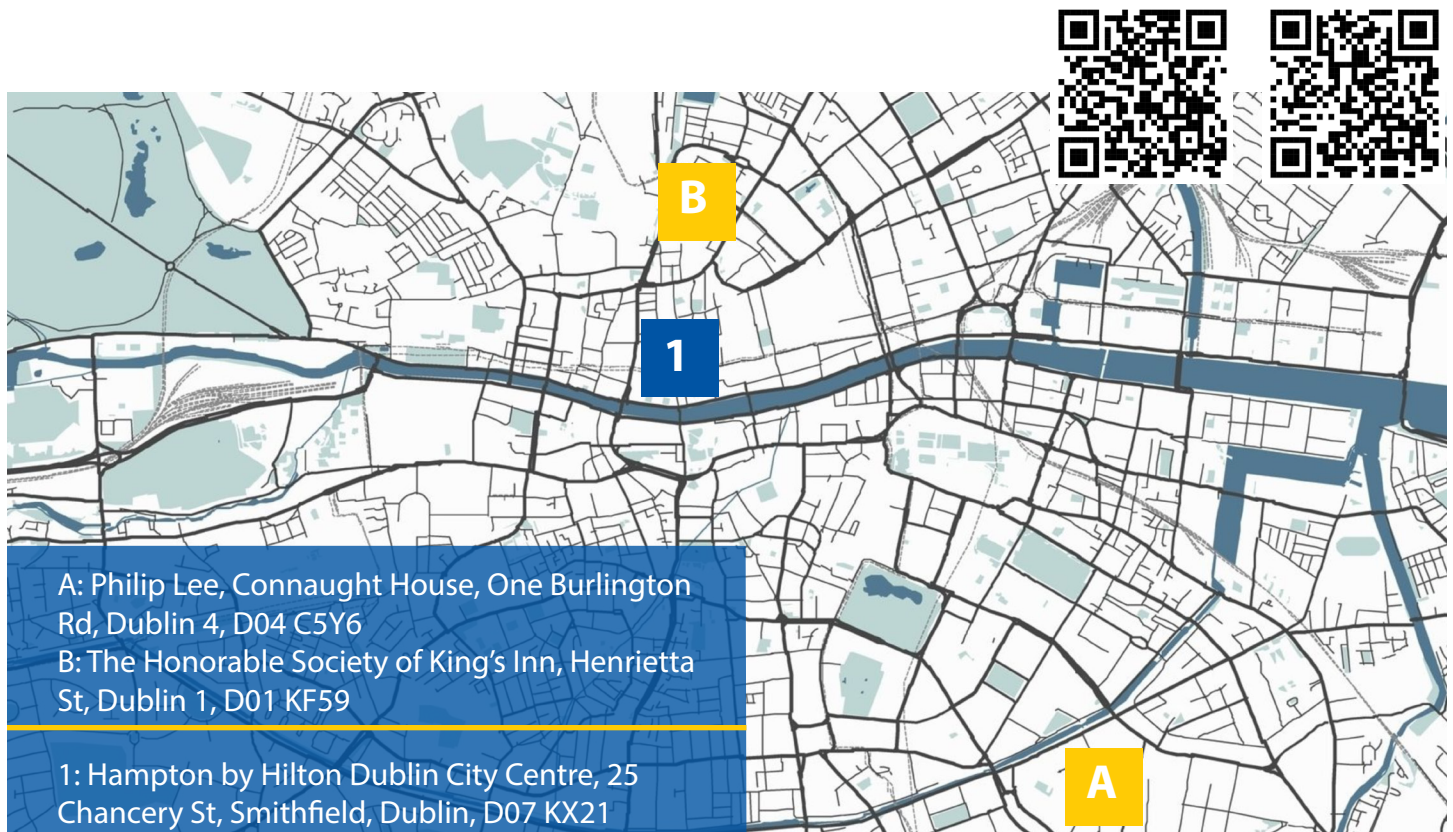
## PHILIPLEE



**Connaught House, One Burlington Rd, Dublin 4, D04 C5Y6**

From Hampton by Hilton Dublin: Head to the Four Courts bus stop (3-minute walk). Take bus 39A or 70 in the direction of UCD or Burlington road respectively. Alight at Burlington Road. The offices are a 5-minute walk. The total journey takes approximately 25 minutes.

From King's Inn: Head to Broadstone (5-minute walk). Take Green Line tram in the direction of Brides Glen. Alight at Charlemont. The offices are a 13-minute walk. The total journey takes approximately 36 minutes.



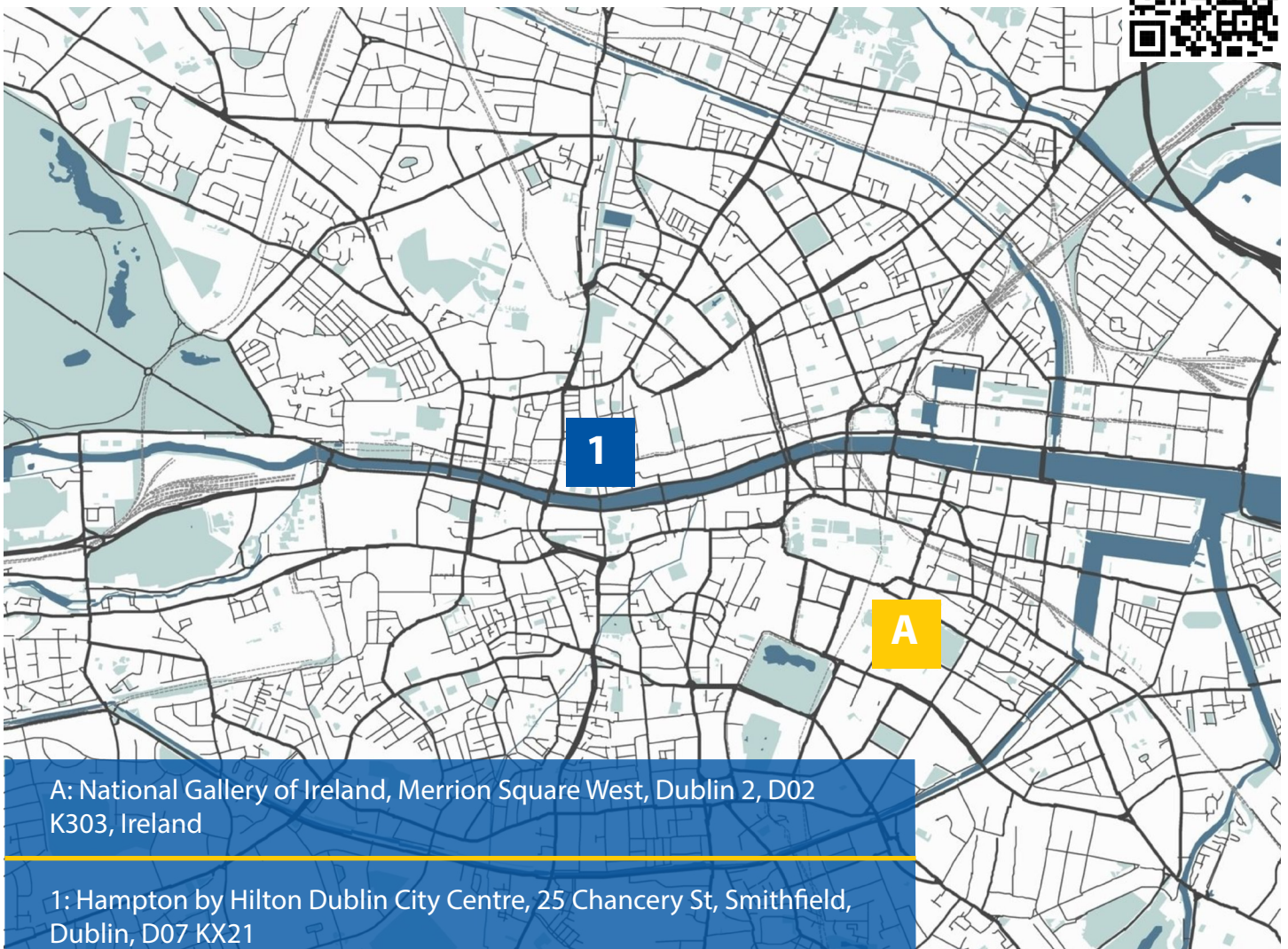


# How to get to the National Gallery of Ireland



## Information desk at Merrion Square West, Dublin 2, D02 K303

From Hampton by Hilton Dublin: Head to the Four Courts (3-minute walk). Take bus 26 in the direction of Merrion Square. Alight at Merrion Square West. The Gallery is a 3-minute walk. Alternatively, take bus 39 or 39A from Four Courts in the direction of UDC. Alight at Merrion Row. The Gallery is a 5 minute walk away. The total journey takes between 16 to 25 minutes.
