Announcement of the webinar no. 2

The ELI Global Private Law Special Interest Group in Global Private Law is pleased to invite you to the second webinar of our Group:

Comparing the law of real estate and security rights with a new system: The Round Table of Security Rights over Immovable Property and the vdpmortgage.com database

Description

Since 2005, the Association of German Pfandbrief Banks (Verband deutscher Pfandbriefbanken, vdp) has been inviting a group of academics and practitioners in mortgage and land register law from over 30 countries to Berlin twice a year to discuss legal developments. They form the “*Round Table of Security Rights over Immovable Property*” and have developed a unique method of visualized comparative law. The results are stored in the database www.vdpmortgage.com, which in 2023 has been made available to the public and are updated and extended permanently. Andreas Luckow shall explain the objectives and working methods of this comparative law project and demonstrate some of the most remarkable results in real estate, land register and mortgage finance law.

Speaker

Andreas Luckow is working with the Association of German Pfandbrief Banks in Berlin (vdp), an industry organization comprising about 50 German and Austrian banks since 2002, now as deputy department head for cover assets. His special field is security in international real estate finance. He is also engaged with Pfandbrief law. In these fields, he has been working comparatively in law in theory and practice with the industry. He is a lawyer and solicitor with degrees from Freiburg 1985 and Berlin 1988 and has been working in banks for 14 years.
